

# Casa Santa Eufémia



The Quinta de Santa Eufémia, Founded in 1894 by Bernardo Rodrigues de Carvalho, is situated on the left bank of the river Douro, at an altitude of 300 meters, between Peso da Régua and Pinhão, in the heart of the oldest demarcated wine-producing region in the world - THE DOURO, a land of secrets and unmistakable aromas, like the 40 hectares of vineyard of this Estate. Grown among schist terraces, 80% of the vines, of the varieties of Tinta Barroca, Touriga Francesa, Tinta Roriz, Touriga Nacional, Tinto Cão, and Tinta Amarela, are farmed under a mechanised system, and 20%, encompassing the white varieties of Malvazia Fina, Malvazia Rei, Moscatel Galego and Cerceal, are farmed according to the traditional method.

At the "Casa de Sta. Eufémia", the care of our workforce and the discerning selection which characterise our quality, result in a distinct winemaking process, producing the taste and aroma which distinguish us in the market. Sharing that quality is the unique moment we would like to celebrate with you in the creation of this Estate Wine without equal anywhere in the world.

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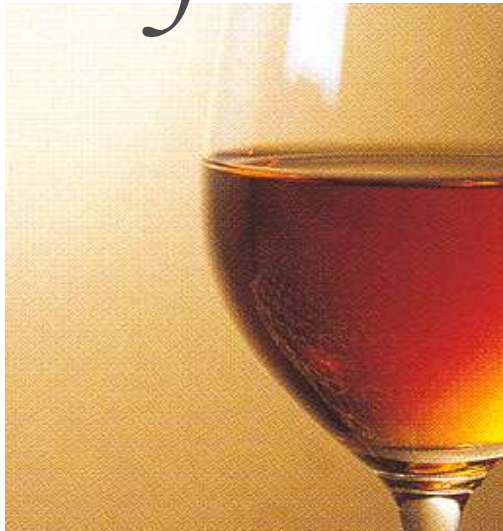

For you to be able to share in and enjoy this paradise, we have reconstructed the "**Casa da Quinta**", a refuge from the XIX Century. Originally a granary for storing agricultural implements, dry fruits and animal feed, it was restored in 1991, and is now the home of the Estate owners.

This two-storey slate and granite building has three double bedrooms for guests, a shared lounge and a spacious dining room. The decoration is dominated by family objects and furniture characteristic of the turn of the century.

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The hospitality and privileged situation offered to guests at the Casa de Quinta de Santa Eufémia encourage them to make a voyage of discovery of the region.

For those wishing to learn how to make quality Port Wine, nothing could be better than taking part in the agricultural activities of the production cycle of the region's divine product.
